AFS Intercultural Programs Philippines and the U.S. Embassy in the Philippines are pleased to announce the opening of applications for the next cycle of the Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study (2019-2020 Batch). This program is a U.S. government-funded exchange programs designed to expand communication between the people of the United States and partner countries with sizeable Muslim populations in the interest of promoting mutual understanding and respect. YES program offers full scholarship to high school students, including students with physical disabilities, in 51 countries. Students will live with host families, attend a U.S. high school, engage in activities to learn about American society and values, acquire leadership skills, and help educate Americans about their countries and cultures. The YES program is funded by the U.S. Department of State - Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs in partnership with the American Councils for International Education and the YES program consortium.

The goals of the program are to:

- Promote a better understanding among youth from selected YES countries about American society, people, institutions, values, and culture;
- · Foster lasting personal ties;
- Engage the exchange participants in activities that promote mutual understanding, respect for diversity, leadership skills, and an understanding of civil society during their exchange in the U.S.;
- · Enhance Americans' understanding of foreign students' countries and cultures; and
- Increase the capacity of organizations in participating countries to engage youth in activities that enhance mutual understanding, respect for diversity, leadership skills, and an understanding of civil society through alumni activities.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Philippine citizen residing in the Philippines at the time of application, selection and preparation for travel; Birthdate must be between August 2, 2001 and August 1, 2004.
- 2. Currently enrolled in a public/private junior or senior high school and is among the top 25% of academic performance in grade level; Graduating senior high school (Grade 12) students are not eligible to apply.
- 3. Demonstrated leadership potential in school and/or community.
- 4. Have an equivalent of a B average or better without failing grades.
- 5. Have not completed more than 11 years of primary education nor received a high school diploma (senior high school) by the start of the program.
- 6. Demonstrated English language ability sufficient to study in a native English-medium setting.
- 7. Sufficiently healthy to participate.
- 8. Preferably have not previously studied in the U.S.
- 9. Committed to cultural immersion in the U.S. through a home-stay experience.
- 10. Able to meet cross-cultural challenges with maturity, humor and open mind.
- 11. Plans to share his/her U.S. experience with his/her home and community upon return.

The program can support Persons with Disabilities (PWD) and encourages their participation.

- 2. Photocopy of most recent Form 137 or transcript of records from your Philippine high school

- 5. AFS PHI will announce (and will notify) ONLY the semifinalists starting by the last week of July. Only semifinalists are invited to the interviews during the months of August to October.
