Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso, shall include all taxes, duties, and/or levies payable.

Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

III. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

All prospective bidders must submit the legal, technical, and financial documents as required by law, including but not limited to: Mayor's Permit, BIR Certificate of Registration, DTI/SEC/CDA registration, and a valid Tax Clearance.

Additionally:

- The specific brand/model unit being offered must be covered by a Brochure or Technical Data Sheet.
- A valid and current Certificate of Resellership issued by the manufacturer must be submitted.
- A Manufacturer's Certificate indicating that the bidder is an Authorized Service Provider of the brand being offered must be submitted.
- The bidder must have PhilGEPS Membership (Platinum).

IV. OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The supplier must:

- Provide User and System Manuals, Technical Materials, Recovery Utilities (e.g., USB recovery drive), and complete documentation of the equipment including an inventory of components and their corresponding brand, model, and serial numbers.
- Provide a list of authorized service centers nationwide in Metro Manila.
- Ensure uninterrupted subscription coverage for the full three-year duration at no additional cost to NCDA.
- Create and configure the Microsoft 365 Tenant under NCDA's official credentials.
- Assign and formally turn over full Global Administrator access to designated MIS personnel.
- Ensure all thirty (30) licenses are properly assigned under NCDA control.



- Ensure no third party retains administrative control or privileged access after turnover, unless authorized in writing by NCDA.
- Ensure all data stored in Microsoft 365 remains the exclusive property of NCDA.

V. DELIVERY:

- The supplier must deliver (one-time delivery) the 30 Desktop Computer Units within Forty-Five (45) calendar days at the NCDA Building, Isidora Street, Brgy. Holy Spirit, Quezon City, after receipt of the Notice to Proceed.
- Fifteen (15) days prior to the delivery, the supplier must inform NCDA in writing of the complete delivery schedule to allow proper coordination with the inspecting officer.
- In case of changes to the delivery schedule, the supplier must inform NCDA in writing at least three (3) days prior to the agreed delivery date, stating the reasons for the change.
- Failure to complete delivery within the stipulated time will result in a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total contract price for every day of delay until completion.

VI. WARRANTY:

The supplier must ensure that NCDA receives the following:

- A Certificate on the Availability of Spare Parts to guarantee immediate replacement of defective parts within the warranty period. The bidder
- Shall ensure the availability of spare parts for at least five (5) years from the purchase date.
- Spare parts or components must be supplied promptly, but no later than seven (7) days from receipt of a service request.



- A test must be conducted by the supplier, witnessed by the NCDA inspection team, during or after the delivery to ensure that all units are functioning properly before final acceptance.
- Defective parts must be replaced free of charge during the warranty period.
- The supplier must provide on-call technical support eight (8) hours a day, seven (7) days a week.

VII. OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- The supplier must have completed a single contract similar to the contract to be bid, with a value at least equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC). For this purpose, a similar contract means the supply and delivery of desktop computers.
- The supplier must be a reputable Information Technology firm with at least five (5) years of business operation.
- The Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) shall conduct post-qualification in accordance with RA No. 12009 to validate the legal, technical, and financial capability of the bidder.
- The brand of the product offered must be in the market for at least 20 years in the Philippines.
- The product offered must have a Philippine office with a technical support group.
- Supplier must have a technical support office in Metro Manila with contact details. Supplier and product must have information readily available on the internet.
- Product offered must have a reputable consumer review.
- Brand of product offered should have good manufacturing practices and should engage in eco-friendly practices.
- The supplier must have similar projects with other government agencies.



VIII. MODE OF PROCUREMENT:
