I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) is to provide backup power and protect electronic equipment from power-related issues.

The UPS provides temporary power to devices during a power outage, allowing for safe shutdown or continuous operation. It protects against voltage sags (brownouts) and surges by stabilizing the incoming power. UPS prevents data loss or corruption by giving users time to save work and shut systems down properly.

Most importantly, UPS prevent hardware damage such as computers, servers, network, communication devices and other ICT equipment's.

This UPS will be use to backup all NCDA Servers, networks and communications devices to ensure business continuity, prevent data loss and corruption of the information system and avoid major operational setbacks.
